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INTRODUCTION

Having recently worked on four projects in Co Roscommon, I attempted to produce a 'family tree' of the Anglican parishes in the county in order to understand how they had been progressively gathered into larger groups since the late nineteenth century. Using the standard reference works, I was unable to find or deduce a satisfactory answer for a number of parishes and decided to investigate further. A volunteer living locally offered to assist and drew my attention to the existence of locally held registers for Kilmore Church, which was closed in the 1990s. This transcript is the result and more projects in this part of the country will follow in due course.

The following points should be borne in mind when using the transcript:

Dates All dates have been standardised as follows; day in numbers, month in three letters (abbreviated as necessary), year.

Legibility and Spelling Indecipherable or uncertain details, whether due to illegible handwriting or faded ink, are marked by a ?

Illiteracy Those who made a mark in the registers are indicated by an 'x' after their name.

Missing Information A dash '-' is used to indicate that the expected information (name, date etc) is absent from the entry.

The Index The index lists in alphabetical order all persons who were recorded as baptised and married at Kilmore over the period 1845-1977. Where circumstantial evidence points to entries for more than one event for the same person, they have been included on the same line in the index. In the absence of any such evidence they have been listed separately.

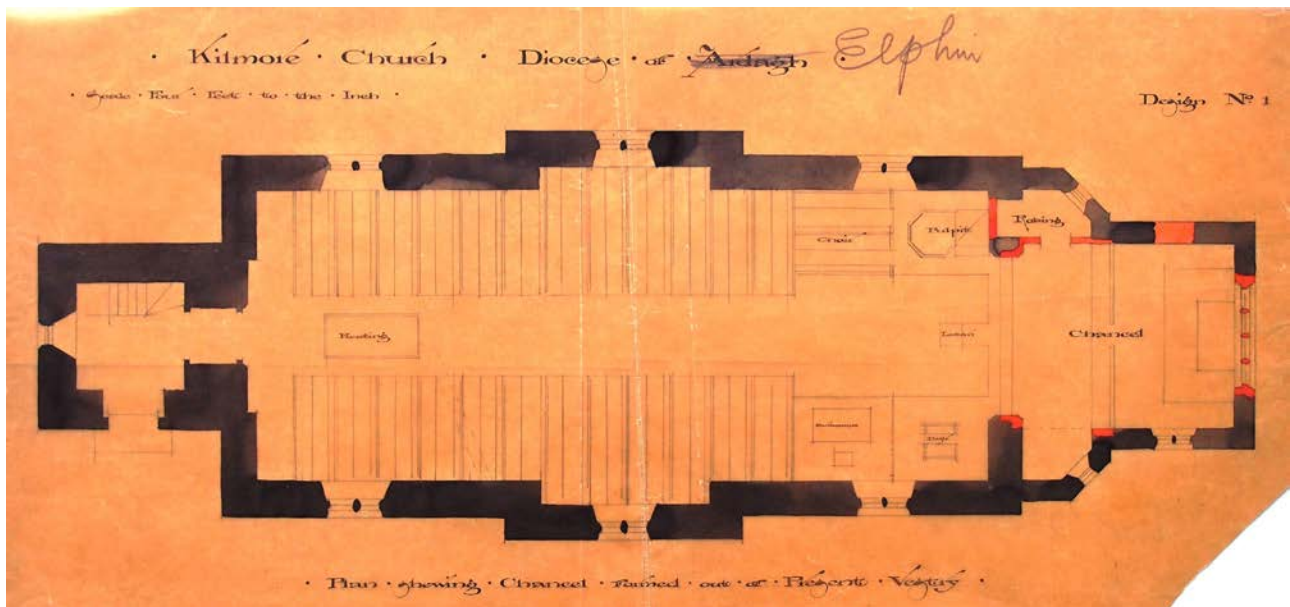

BRIEF HISTORY OF THE PARISH AND CHURCH

Kilmore is an ancient parish in Co Roscommon, 2½ miles S by W from Drumsna on the road to Elphin, and comprises 9316 statute acres (5883 titheable). This parish is bounded on the north and east by the river Shannon, which on the latter side expands into the picturesque Lough Bodarig; on the south it borders upon the lough of Gillstown. The living was a rectory in the diocese of Elphin.

Kilmore was united with Killukin in 1884, with Annaduff (in the Diocese of Ardagh) in 1933 and with Termonbarry (also in the Diocese of Ardagh) in 1955. In 1959 it was then transferred to the Diocese of Ardagh, and united with Kiltoghart and Toomna 1959-1996, and with also with Drumshambo and Kilronan 1962-1996. The parish is now covered by the **South Leitrim Group** (previously known as the Mohill Group).

Kilmore Church was built about 1828 with a loan of £923 from the late Board of First Fruits (BFF). In his *Topographical Dictionary of Ireland* (1837) Lewis described it as a 'neat building in good repair'. This drawing of the ground plan dates from about 1865, when a chancel was created from the vestry at the East end.

The glebe-house was also built in 1828 with a loan of £360 and a gift of £369 from the BFF. There was a glebe of nine acres.

The church was officially closed in 1996, although services ceased about 1980. It has since been leased by the RCB to a local community group that has repaired the roof and kept the building in good order, although not using it for any specific purpose.

LINKED PARISHES

The various parishes united to Kilmore over the years are covered by the South Leitrim (previously Mohill) or Boyle Groups of Parishes, as noted below.

Killukin is an ancient parish in Co Roscommon, on the road from Carrick-on-Shannon to Ballina, containing part of the market and post-town of Carrick and comprising 5970 statute acres (3571 titheable). The living was a rectory in the diocese of Elphin, and united to the vicarages of Kilbrine and Kilcorkey and the rectory of Ardcarne, together forming the Killuken Union. Killukin was united to Kilmore in 1884, and also transferred to the Diocese of Ardagh in 1959. **South Leitrim Group.**

Killukin Church was a very old building in Killukin townland. The glebe-house was built in 1816; the BFF gave £400 and lent £240. The glebe comprised 13 acres. The church was closed in 1962 and subsequently demolished.

Ardcarne is an ancient parish in Co Roscommon, 3½ miles ESE from Boyle, on the road to Carrick-on-Shannon. It is situated on the shores of Lough Key, partly bounded by the Shannon on the east and comprises 19962 statute acres (11460 titheable). The rectory formed part of the Killukin Union in the Diocese of Elphin. Ardcarne was united with Croghan 1949-1955 and then with Boyle from 1956. **Boyle Group.**

Ardcarne Church is an ancient structure, which was enlarged by a grant of £600 from the BFF, and the Ecclesiastical Commissioners granted £234 for its further repair in the 1830s. The glebe-house was built by aid of a gift of £100 and a loan of £300 from the BFF in 1807: the glebe comprises 90 acres.

Kilbrine (or Kilbryan) is an ancient parish in Co Roscommon, 1¼ miles SSE from Boyle and of 3852 statute acres. Lough Key is chiefly in this parish. The vicarage formed part of the Killuken Union in the Diocese of Elphin. It was then united to Kilmactranny (Co Sligo) from 1883 and eventually, after many moves in the intervening years, to Boyle in 2003. Lewis (1837) did not mention a church. The church was closed in 1996. **Boyle Group.**

Kilcorkey is an ancient parish in Co Roscommon, 2 miles SE from Frenchpark on the new mail coach road from Longford to Ballina, and comprising 9090 statute acres (6102 titheable). It was united to Killuken in the Diocese of Elphin. **South Leitrim Group.**

Aughrim is an ancient parish in Co Roscommon, 3½ miles south of Carrick-on-Shannon, on the road from Drumsna to Elphin and on the River Shannon. It comprises some 8254 acres (5316 titheable) and

was previously known as Tirebrine. The living was a vicarage in the Diocese of Elphin, with the rectory forming the corps of the prebend of Tirebrine in the Cathedral Church of Elphin. In 1811 it was united with the rectory and vicarage of Cloonaff and the vicarage of Killumod to form the Aughrim Union. From 1848 it was joined with Killukin. **South Leitrim Group.**

Aughrim Church was built in 1744 in Ardlougher townland. It was described by Lewis in 1837 as a 'neat plain building with a small spire', having been recently repaired by a grant of £154 from the Ecclesiastical Commissioners. There was no glebe-house. The ruins of the old church in Aughrim townland, in which some of the Earls of Roscommon were buried, were also visible at that time. Aughrim Church was closed in 1933, temporarily at first, and then permanently. Its demolition in September 1955 was reported in the *Roscommon Herald*.

Cloonaff (or Cloncraft) is an ancient parish 5 miles NNE from Strokestown on the shore of Lough Baffin and comprising 9471 acres. It was united to Aughrim in 1811. The old church and graveyard were in Cloonaff townland. **South Leitrim Group.**

Killumod (or Killummod) is an ancient parish 3 miles SSW from Carrick-on-Shannon and on the road to Elphin. It comprised 5159 acres (2883 titheable) and was also united to Aughrim in 1811. It included the ruins of an old church with attached graveyard in Killumod townland and a second graveyard in Knockroe townland. **South Leitrim Group.**

Ebenezer King (ek) is not listed in *Clergy of Kilmore, Elphin and Ardagh*. He was the third son of Sir Robert King, 2nd Baronet of Charlestown Co Roscommon and High Sheriff of the county in 1821, and his wife Elizabeth, daughter of Ebenezer Rowe of Ballyharty, Co Wexford. He entered TCD in 1833 aged 18 and graduated BA in 1838. A newspaper report of 28 Feb 1851 described him as 'Curate of Kilmore'. He died on 30 May 1851 and there is a memorial to him in Kilmore Church. The death notice in a newspaper of 7 Jun 1851 said that he died at Kilmore Glebe, the residence of his brother Robert King. Probate in 1851 also described him as 'of Kilmore Glebe'.
